**I take advantage of the Feast of the Epiphany of Our Lord, which is also the celebration of Traditional Monarchy, and the visit of the person I have appointed head of my Political Secretariat, to address the loyalists of Hispanidad scattered throughout the five continents.**

**As you know, I spent the last year with health complications from which I have not fully recovered. I do not know what Providence has in store for us in this year that has just begun. ***I urge you to strengthen discipline in times that require the greatest clarity of doctrine and unity of action.* For this I have just given you appropriate instructions. May God grant that I may soon meet you in person.**
